THE BANKS' AFRICAN STAFF UNION.

A rather pleasant and happy evening was spent on
 Monday the 4th instant "Bank Holiday" at the Glover
 Memorial Hall when there was held by the members of
 the Banks' African Staff Union a grand Conversation which
 no doubt proved to be the first of its kind in the history of
 the Bank in Lagos.

At 8 o'clock p.m. the following gentlemen were already
 in evidence—Messrs E. C. Hodgett, Manager Bank of
 British West Africa Ltd., J. F. W. Schofield joint Manager
 of Colonial Bank D. D. Gibb, Sub Manager B. B. W.A.
 Ltd., Mrs. D. D. Gibb, A. Conacher Accountant, Colonial
 Bank, Lawyer Rhodes, S. H. Baptist, Jibowu, Franklin,
 Folarin, Mr. P. J. C. Thomas, Mr. Duro Thomas, Mr. J. A.
 Oduinsade, Mrs. S. H. Pearse, etc. and with the twinkling
 of an eye the whole Hall had been packed full.

After several interesting Recitations and songs, the play,
 the Pantomime of "The Advantages of Banking" began.
 "The Manager of the Bank that Never Fails started with
 an introductory appeal a very attractive and convincing
 one urging every one who might hear the play to keep his
 or her savings at the Bank that Never Fails" where a
 depositor of £9 may draw £10 and still has £1 to his credit.
 "This appeal gave rise to such laughter from the audience,
 particularly those connected with the Banking's concerns"
 who though not doubting the ability of the General Manager
 of the Bank that Never Fails, yet cannot see the possibility
 of such a business in real life.

Another most miraculous sort of business that the Bank
 transacts is the issuing of its Letter of Credit which can be
 negotiated in the North, South, East, and West; above the

sky, by aeroplane and by submarine under the bed of the
 sea—a wonder not found perhaps in wonderland.

The first scene of the first act portrays a mail Day in the
 Bank that never fails when clients are busy transacting
 various kinds of business such as, cashing cheques, depositing
 monies in the savings Department, receiving interest on
 Fixed Deposits, purchasing Draft, and making Tele-
 graphic Transfers, while three gentlemen Messrs Riskitt,
 Dickinson, and Abdul would not avail themselves of these
 facilities on account of the Bank's trifling charges.

The second scene describes the incident on the wharf
 when passengers were embarking on the Liner "Zaria"
 sailing for Europe and other parts of the world quite
 unfortunately Mr. Riskitt's hand bag which, some people
 say, contains money exceeding £32,000,000 was smartly
 changed.

Dickinson the second gentleman of the three who
 ignored the Bank's facility also dropped packets of Currency
 Notes as he was climbing up the ship's gangway, Mr.
 Dickinson told only a friend and that quite secretly that he
 was bound for Jamaica.

In the second act appeared one Mr. Felix George
 attempting to move the specie required by his firm at their
 up-country branches when quite unhappily, he and the
 labourers were encountered by highwaymen who injured
 them and went away with the money. Next came Mr.
 Abdul the third of those who refused to keep their money at
 the "Bank that Never Fails" Abdul's house was on fire,
 while Fire Brigade and Boys Scouts hurried to the scene to
 put down the fire.

In spite of all efforts to save every thing for Abdul, £5000
 worth of currency Notes was to his sorrow reported as
 having been destroyed by the fire.

The play ended at 10.30 p.m. when dance commenced
 until the small hours of the morning. The first dance was
 by the Bank Staff only and at this stage the absence of
 Hon. W. F. Becker was regrettably felt. The function
 was a decided success.

Heartly congratulations to the members of the Union.
